These are the curriculum areas we will be working on in December!

Language:

- Students will continue to generate, gather and organize ideas for personal writing tasks
- Students will continue to use skills from their writer's tool box (adding detail, using figurative language, million dollar words, etc.) to improve their writing.
- Students will practice summarizing a variety of texts in the context of our health and social studies lessons

Math:

- Number Sense and Numeration Multiplication and Division
- Number Sense and Numeration Proportional Reasoning and Unit Rate
