

# March at a Glance...

These are the curriculum areas we will be working on this month.

## Language:

- **Writer's Workshop** ~ Students will be finishing up their personal memoirs. Then, we will be exploring descriptive writing. Students will be asked to create a character that they have to write a very detailed paragraph about.
- **Reader's Workshop** - Students will be presenting their Book Talks - their purpose is to inform their audience about the book of their choice and try to convince them to read the book.

## Math:

- **Problem Solving**
  - We will be spending the few weeks before March Break exploring the problem solving model. Students will be asked to solve a variety of problems that will require them to think critically about what the question is asking, what operation (+, -, x, ÷) needs to be done.
- **Geometry and Spatial Sense and Measurement**
  - After March Break students will be introduced to a new project that will have them exploring concepts of volume, area, perimeter, fractions, angles, and much much more!
  - They will be designing their very own 3D City!

## Science:

**Grade 4** - We will be starting the "Rocks and Minerals" unit. Focusing on their properties and use in daily life.

**Grade 5** - We will be starting the "Energy Conservation" unit. Focusing on types of energy and how humans meet the demands for energy.

## **Art**

We will be looking at 3 Dimensional art.

## **Health**

We will be looking at internet safety.
