

November at a Glance...

These are the curriculum areas we will be working on in October!

Language:

- Students will be exploring the "Rant" as a form of writing. They will be looking at persuasive techniques, as well as writing from a specific point of view.
- Students will continue to generate, gather and organize ideas for personal writing tasks.
- Students will practice summarizing a variety of texts, including our class read aloud "The Wild Robot"
- Students will practice Reading is Thinking through responses to self selected reading opportunities.

Math:

- Data Management - collect, organize, display and analyze data
- Geometry and Spatial Sense - classify and construct polygons and angles

Science:

Biodiversity

- Students will develop an understanding of the benefits of biodiversity and issues related to biodiversity.
- Students will be analyze a local biodiversity issue from different points of view and produce a detailed report covering the issue.
